Position Available: MSHSL Rules Clinician for One Act Play

Responsibilities:

1. Provide advice to One Act Play coaches/directors and judges regarding One Act Play Bylaws, rules and procedures.
2. Coordinate and present annual training clinics for judges.
3. Provide advice to MSHSL Assistant Director regarding Rules Manual revisions.
4. Serve as liaison between the activity's coaches/directors and MSHSL staff, as needed.
5. Assist with the maintenance of a Rules Interpretation F.A.Q. database available to the activity's directors, participants, and judges.
6. Advise the Assistant Director regarding rule interpretations and communication of rule interpretations to coaches and judges statewide.
7. Provide timely assistance to section tournament directors regarding rules questions/concerns.
8. Assist with state festival preparations and activities, as needed.

Qualifications:

1. Experience directing and/or judging the activity at the high school level, preferably both
2. Knowledge of rules and procedures of the activity and of the MSHSL
3. Availability for coach/judge communication, including the ability to answer questions in a timely fashion
4. Ability to set aside all potential conflicts of interest, both personal and professional
5. (Preferred) Section or State tournament administration or judging experience
6. Experience leading training clinics, or similar
7. Preferably retired from directing
