Carlson, Cornelius, Kreft, Prestby selected 2018 MSHSL Triple “A” Award recipients

Noah Carlson of Houston High School, Kevin Cornelius of Orono High School, Brianna Kreft of West Central Area High School and Allison Prestby of Alexandria Area High School were awarded the Minnesota State High School League Academic, Arts, and Athletics Award on March 24 during ceremonies held at the Loews Hotel in Minneapolis.

Established in 1988, the award, known as the Triple “A” Award, recognizes and rewards high school seniors from across the state for their achievements in the classroom, the arts, and athletics. To qualify for the award, students must have a “B” or better grade-point average and participate in League-sponsored athletic and fine arts activities. League member schools are invited to nominate two students – a boy and a girl – for the award.

Award recipients are selected through a multi-level process involving the League’s administrative regions and a committee of athletic, fine arts and educational leaders. One girl and one boy from Class A schools and one girl and one boy from Class AA schools receive a four-year, \$1,000 scholarship. Following are brief profiles of the 2018 Academics, Arts, and Athletics Award winners, plus all of the finalists.
